Job Title: Laminator

Department: Production

Organizational Relationship: Reports directly to the Lamination Supervisor

Job Description: Performs fiberglass lamination activities as required by the customer and/or for production. The following are the duties and responsibilities of the Laminator – either performed directly and/or via subordinates:

- Mold inspection prior to production, clean and repair as needed, and mask off areas which are not to be laminated
- Experience with various resins, gel-coats, fiberglass materials, foam and other adhesives
- Spray chopped fiberglass, resins and catalysts onto prepared molds or dies using pneumatic spray guns with chopper attachments - release air bubbles and smooth seams, using rollers
- Select precut fiberglass mats, cloth and wood bracing materials per production requirements
- Pat or press layers of saturated mat or cloth into place on molds, using brushes or hands, and smooth out wrinkles and air bubbles with hands or squeegees
- Mix catalysts into resins, and saturate cloth and mats with mixtures, using brushes
- Install wood or other components to hulls, desk and molds
- Operate certain power tools not limited to chop gun, saws, drills, grinders and hoists
- Check completed products for conformity and repair or modify discrepancies if detected
- Follow safety and health standards – use of face respirators, gloves, eye protection and other equipment as required
- Ability to work 8+ hour day shifts (standing, bending and reaching) and moderate lifting up to 50 lbs. (standing 100%, bending 50%, kneeling 20%)
- Safety conscience - safety glasses, closed shoes, gloves, respirator/dust mask

Preferred Qualifications: To perform this job successfully the individual must be able to perform each assigned duty and responsibility satisfactorily. The requirements listed are representative of the knowledge, skill and/or ability required. Must read and write English and have a high school diploma or GED.

Education/Experience/Competency: 6 months to 1 year related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.
