



# Job Description

**Job Title:** Paint/Spray Booth Operator

**Department:** Production

**Organizational Relationship:** Reports directly to the Production Supervisor

**Job Description:** Performs a variety paint/spray responsibilities as required by the customer and/or for production. The following are the duties and responsibilities of the Paint/Spray Booth Operator – either preformed directly and/or via subordinates:

- Surface preparation (fiberglass, metals, wood, acrylic, etc.) for painting/spraying and drying
- Preps, setups (color matching and mixing) and paints/sprays – finishing/detailing as needed
- Experience with resins, gelcoats, fiberglass materials, foam, adhesives and metals
- Runs and maintains all paint/spray booth equipment and compressors
- Operate light hand power tools not limited to sanders, drills, grinders, hoists and additional specialty tools as required for production
- Check, inspect and troubleshoot component surfaces, paint/spray and/or assembly related, for conformity and repair discrepancies if detected
- Manage booth inventory requirements and submits procurement request as needed
- Follow safety and health standards – use of dust masks, respirators, gloves, eye protection and other protective equipment as required
- Ability to work 8+ hour day shifts (standing, bending and reaching) and moderate lifting up to 50 lbs. (standing 100%, bending 50%, kneeling 20%)
- Safety conscience - safety glasses, closed shoes, gloves, respirator/dust mask

**Preferred Qualifications:** To perform this job successfully the individual must be able to perform each assigned duty and responsibility satisfactorily. The requirements listed are representative of the knowledge, skill and/or ability required. Must read and write English and have a high school diploma or GED.

**Education/Experience/Competency:** Two to five years related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.
