Job Title: Engineering Manager

Department: Engineering

Organizational Relationship: Reports directly to the Project Manager

Job Type: Full-Time

Shift: 1st Shift Monday – Friday

Job Overview: The Engineer Manager performs, assigns and manages engineering tasks on product and project orders. He / She will oversee other engineers in the department and will report directly to the Project Director. The Engineer Manager leads the execution and timely completion of all engineering required drawings, specifications, calculations, bill of materials and other engineering deliverables as required by the project specifications.

Engineering Duties:

- Engineering staff shall deliver all project / product design drawings and other engineering documents on time per project schedule, specifications and client requirements.
- Shall be responsible for performing, assigning and / or managing system design and engineering tasks for the power and process industries.
- Shall manages and interface with our third party engineering / drafting support and hold them accountable to meet project schedule and deliverables.
- Shall review and approve engineering drawings (Internal / External) to meet the accuracy and buildability of manufacturing processes.
- Shall be responsive to other employees by providing direction or technical feedback within 24 hours of the request.
- Shall provide weekly reports to Project Manager on current engineering deliverables and schedules.
- Performs, assigns and supports Factory Acceptance Testing and client interface when required.
- Assigns and manages the creation of manufacturing drawing shop packages that must meet production request and schedules.
- Analyze engineering drawings, specifications and related data to determine arrangement for production
- Create concepts, performance and production criteria
- Evaluate and approve design changes, specifications, and drawings
- Modify existing programs and processes to enhance efficiency
- The Engineer Manager must communicate effectively in both oral and written forms. He/she will disseminate clear and concise technical reporting essential for the products/projects and its team members.



- Follow safety and health standards – use of personal protective equipment as required
- Work overtime as needed
- Other tasks as assigned by the Project Manager/Management

Minimum Requirements:

- At least 5 years in an Engineer Supervisor/Management position
- Proficient in SolidWorks, Auto CAD and other engineering programs
- Proficient in Microsoft Office Programs (Word, Excel, Spreadsheet, ect.)
- Good verbal and written communication skills
- Must be able to work 8+ hour day shifts (sitting, standing, bending, and reaching) and moderate lifting up to 50lbs.
