Job Title: Vacuum Infusion Technician

Department: Production

Organizational Relationship: Reports directly to Production Supervisor

Job Description: The management and coordination of the day-to-day vacuum infusion operations, suitable working environment and production activities as directed by the Production Supervisor and/or other members of leadership. The following are the duties and responsibilities of the Vacuum Infusion Technician:

- Application of composite/fiberglass lamination and fabrication techniques to mold surfaces as well as stacking of raw materials for infusion process
- Extensive knowledge of gelcoats, resins and additional required raw materials
- Under limited supervision plumbing vacuum and feed lines in and out of part
- Vacuum pump maintenance experience
- Quality assurance inspection of all raw materials
- Understanding of raw material and dimensional measurements
- Nonconformity detection, identification of cause and corrective action recommendation
- Assist with essential services of maintenance, cleaning, waste disposal and recycling
- Evaluate in-process risks and develop methods of improvement
- Assist in efforts to reduce scrap and rework costs
- Must have general skills of hand tools and machinery as required
- Organize infusion work area, maintain a clean environment and plan the necessary tasks required to meet or exceed expectations.
- Understand and comply with health, safety and regulatory requirements
